For our reseller customers, we have an automated workflow that :

- 1. Defaults the order to be "Blind"
- 2. Requires a customer supplied packing list if available
- 3. Requires customer part numbers
- 4. Defaults the "Shipper Address" on FedEx/UPS labels to be customer's warehouse address.
- 5. Creates Product Tags and Box Identifiers with customer's logo (if provided) and part numbers. Each carton is labeled with
 - a. Package #
 - b. Weight/Dimensions
 - c. Package Contents (using customer provided part numbers)
