

## **Conductor Color Guide**

The Current-Carrying conductor is insulated with a PVC material that is generally colored in multiple-conductor cordage to help distinguish between each conductor. These are the two most common color conventions: International Color Code and North American Color Code

## **International (ICC)**

Protective Ground: Green-Yellow

**Neutral: Blue** 

Line (Single Phase):
Brown

Line 1 (3-Phase):
Brown

Line 2 (3-Phase): Black

Line 3 (3-Phase): Grey

## **North American (NACC)**

**Protective Ground: Green** 

**Neutral: White** 


Line (Single Phase): Black
