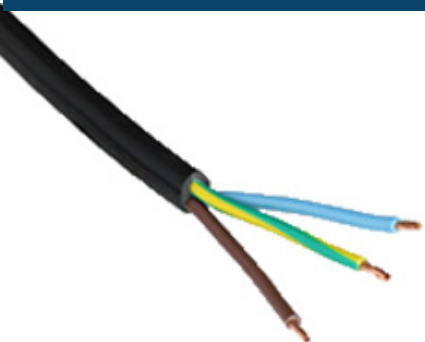




# Conductor Color Guide

The Current-Carrying conductor is insulated with a PVC material that is generally colored in multiple-conductor cordage to help distinguish between each conductor. These are the two most common color conventions: International Color Code and North American Color Code

## International (ICC)



Protective Ground:  
Green-Yellow

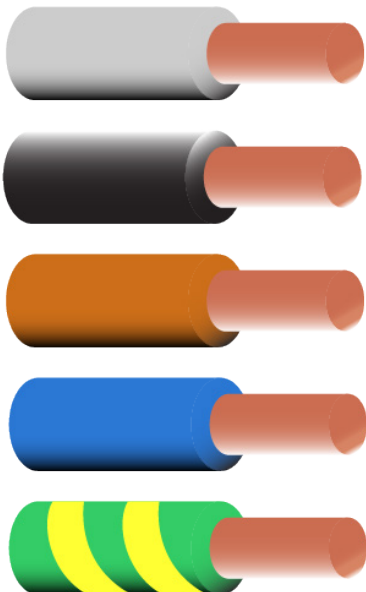
Neutral: Blue

Line (Single Phase):  
Brown

Line 1 (3-Phase):  
Brown

Line 2 (3-Phase):  
Black

Line 3 (3-Phase):  
Grey



## North American (NACC)

Protective Ground: Green

Neutral: White

Line (Single Phase):  
Black

Line 1 (3-Phase):  
Black

Line 2 (3-Phase):  
Red

Line 3 (3-Phase):  
Blue
